ORGANIZED PLAY DOCUMENT

TOURNAMENT ORGANIZER

The tournament organizer is the store or club where the tournament is being held.

If you wish to hold a tournament sponsored by Archon Studio, you must email us via: op.wot@archon-studio.com.

To get support from Archon Studio, you must provide:

1. A link to a social media platform with the tournament announcement post.
2. The application or website that will be used for tracking tournament results. If such a site or app is not available, you must use longshanks.org. While using Longshanks.org, you must provide either the event number, a link to the event, or a link to another tournament tracker.
3. Information on the average number of players participating in card game tournaments and what card games were previously organized.
4. The name of the club/store.
5. The exact address: city, street, postal code.
6. Phone number.
7. Email address.
8. First and last name.

APPLICATION ORDER AND TOURNAMENT PACK AVAILABILITY

1. The number of **tournament support packs** provided by Archon Studio is **strictly limited**.
2. Applications for sponsored tournaments will be processed **in the order they are received**, until all available packs are distributed.
3. **Distributors** also have a **limited number of Tournament Packs** available for purchase — availability is **not guaranteed** and operates on a **first come, first served** basis.
4. Organizers who obtain a pack (either directly from Archon Studio or through a distributor) must still:
 - I. Publish a **social media post** announcing the event.
 - II. Preferably **register the event on longshanks.org** for official tracking and transparency.
5. Archon Studio reserves the right to decline late or incomplete applications once support capacity is reached.

TOURNAMENT KITS AND DISTRIBUTION

You can purchase an official **Tournament Pack** from an authorized **Archon Studio distributor**. If the pack is purchased this way, the organizer must still:

1. Create and publish a **social media post** announcing the tournament.
2. Preferably register the event on longshanks.org (recommended for official ranking and transparency).
3. Follow all other rules and requirements listed in this document.

TOURNAMENT REQUIREMENTS AND RULES

1. The final number of players participating in the competition for prizes sponsored by Archon Studio must be **no less than 12 players**.
2. The organizer should inform Archon Studio well in advance of the tournament date and their intention to organize the event.
3. Tournaments must be played with original **World of Tanks: The Card Game** cards or proxies prepared by the organizer. The proxies shouldn't be easily identifiable when placed next to the original card.
4. Players should prepare their decks in accordance with the **WoT: The Card Game deck-building rules**.
5. To participate in the tournament, players have to sign up on the organizer's list and accept these terms and conditions.
6. The number of spots is limited — the organizer has the right to refuse tournament participation if there are no spots left or to create a waiting list. Acceptance to the tournament is based on the order of registration. Registered players will be randomly paired by the system chosen by the organizer to play against each other (1v1).
7. The time for matches is individually set by the organizer. It is recommended that a single match lasts **30–40 minutes**.
8. After the start of the match, a player may only leave the table with the consent of their opponent or the tournament staff. Otherwise, leaving the game is equivalent to surrendering and results in a loss.
9. The top three players in the tournament will receive prizes sponsored by Archon Studio.
10. The organizer may arrange for additional prizes, their quantity, and distribution; these prizes are sponsored by the organizer.
11. All disputes will be resolved by the tournament staff.

12. The final interpretation of the rules of play and any disputes regarding game rules belong to the tournament staff.
13. The decision of the tournament staff regarding a win is final, and players are not entitled to an appeal.
14. Tournament results must be announced on the organizer's social media along with photos from the matches.
15. The organizer is responsible for the efficient operation of the event. It is unacceptable for the quality of the event to be compromised due to a lack of sufficient staff.
16. The organizer is obligated to hand over the prizes sponsored by Archon Studio to the tournament winners.
17. It is recommended to play **Best-of-3 (B03)** with the following scoring:

3 POINTS FOR A WIN

1 POINT FOR A DRAW

0 POINTS FOR A LOSS

Points are cumulative after each match.

For example, if a player plays 5 B03 matches, winning 3, losing 1, and drawing 1, they will achieve a total of 10 points.

In the event of a tie due to players achieving the same final score at the end of the tournament, the combined total score obtained by the opponents of the tied players should be checked.

However, please note that this is a suggested format for tournament scoring, and the organizer has the right to conduct the tournament in a different format, provided they can document the players' scores and the scoring system they use is fair to every player.

18. Both players and organizers must be familiar with and agree to the rules in the **World of Tanks: The Card Game Tournament Document**.
